Women first began taking to the streets for RECLAIM THE NIGHT in Australia in 1978 and have continued to do so every year in cities and towns across the country.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Submissions accepted from women only.
2. Please only submit your own work.
3. Make sure you include your name and contact details on your submission.
4. Please keep a copy of your work. If you can't make a copy, bring it into The Loft and we can copy it for you here.
5. If you do not have access to a computer, drop in your neat, hand written submission to The Loft Youth Venue, Lvl 1, 7A Wolfe Street, Newcastle, or send to the address below.
6. Electronic Submissions are preferred. We accept Word documents, Publisher Documents, PDFs or JPEGs. Email address below.
7. You are welcome to format your own work. The final copy will be in A5 size so please use a font size 14 if you are submitting an A4 size document so we can still read it when shrunk to A5.
8. Please don't fold or crease your artworks, the printing quality will be affected.
9. The artist/author of each work retains copyright over their submission.
10. If you submit but can't attend RTN 2008 where the magazine will be handed out, contact Fiona or Joanne and we will send you one.
